

194 minutes or longer	99291 x 1 and 99292 as appropriate (see illustrated reporting examples above)

# 99291 is OK for critical care if over 30 min for both

- For CMS: need to eclipse 104 for added 99292
- For Commercial: +99292 can be billed at 75 minutes
